We know that all the different titles in the Orange contract have issues specific to their group and there are bigger issues that affect all titles. We will fight for each group and address all issues. We must remain united in this fight.

The company has already shown an interest in shifting more costs to their employees while lining the pockets of their executives. AT&T has added 18 million wireless customers over the last 5 years, and given their top executives enormous pay increases, it makes it all the more infuriating when they try to shift costs to you.
