- PPM center issue, response issue. Duty Manager after 4:30pm, 518-649-9668 (Tim Breen region.) Call forwarding 6 selections for options when called. Davis gave permission for employees to give local connections with NYSEG, Grid etc. the number for better response from Verizon. PPM center #: internal 1-800-213-9211, outsiders 855-661-6323. Business cards with all numbers in Tim's region to pass out. Davis to ask at the 12/16/24 meeting.
- Emergency response meetings with NYSEG, Grid etc. Davis has attended in the past. No issues discussed.

Open forum for issues:

- Foam filled pole holes, encouraged to cut and cover (done over in buffalo region) Davis to check with Tim on company policy.
- Wheel chalks. Rubber chalks for trailers only. Steele/All metal chalks for vehicles only.
 Phase out old wooden chalks.
- Attenuator training to come in 2025 for people who still need the training. Albany Buffalo Syracuse locations for training.
- Hands on flagging training can be requested, but more to come, going process.
- Strobe lighting, the extra cab and magnetic lights are available from Davis and Jasinski.
- Head light bulb issue. VFleet states DOT required bulbs only.
- Continued defensive driving course. Will be provided to all employees.
- Lead: squirrel guard, bagged and regular dumpster. Lead splices, bagged and put in a metal dumpster. Lead tools need to be separated and labeled from day to day tools. Or cleaned properly.
- Ladder fall: employee used customer ladder. Use verizon ladder only.
- Digging accident: Dug without 811 ticket. Employees struck underground facilities/and or gas lines. Always submit 811 tickets when digging and wait for a cleared ticket prior to digging.
- Decommissioning Copper and Lead State wide to come. New England/Boston/ Syracuse
 has started to phase out aerial/ manholes/ vaults. More to come. A company buying old
 lead and helping with the tear out process with a lead chop truck.
- 3M PAPRs (full face purified respirators) to replace half-faced respirators for man hole work only. No need to shave and get fitted per employee.
- Lead blood testing issue in Plattsburgh. Not receiving test results. Mihou and Davis working on issues with Kim Classen.
- Tier 3 safety meet notes to be passed to LM's to spread out issues and topics in huddles.
